1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to issue joining letter for the post of Civilian Motor Driver.
2. The petitioner pursuant to an advertisement by respondent participated in the selection process and he was selected on the post of Civilian Motor Driver. The respondent has issued posting plan dated 15.03.2023, however, petitioner has not been issued appointment letter. The petitioner has served Legal Notice dated 30.08.2023 (Annexure P-8) upon the respondent still respondent has not paid heed to said Notice.
3. Learned counsel for the respondents- UOI submits that grievance of the petitioner would be redressed by passing an appropriate order within 2 weeks.
4. In the wake of statements, the present petition stands disposed of. The petitioner is at liberty to move an appropriate application, if something survives.
