The reply dated 14.12.2023 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

On 30.10.2023, the following order was passed in this case:-

“ At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is under instructions to not press the prayer with regard to quashing of the FIR.

Notice of motion.

On advance service of copy of petition, learned State counsel appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab and seeks time to file report.

At request, adjourned to 14.12.2023.

Meanwhile, operation of impugned order shall remain stayed subject to petitioner causing appearance before the trial Court within a period of 3 weeks from today and upon his causing appearance, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal bonds to satisfaction of Court below.”.

In deference to the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered before the Court of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Batala and has since been admitted to interim bail as is borne out from the order dated 14.11.2023. A copy of the said order is taken on record as Mark ‘A’.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Disposed of.

It is expected that the petitioner shall henceforth not absent himself from the Trial except for sufficient cause.
