1. On the oral request made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the offence under Section 201 IPC is ordered to be added in the head note as well as in the prayer clause of the present petition. Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to carry out the necessary correction in the Court itself.

2. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.103 dated 25.07.2023 registered under Sections 458, 323, 341, 506, 201, 148, 149 of IPC, at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 23.10.2023 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

4. Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioners

have joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 23.10.2023 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute. The petitioners shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
