Prayer in the second petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.595 dated 09.07.2022 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC, registered at Police Station Azad Nagar, District Hisar (Annexure P-1).

Vide order dated 05.12.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 05.12.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
