In deference to the order dated 20.03.2023. Sh. Navdeep Chhabra, Sr. Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, has produced a copy of the opinion given by the Medical Board. It has been reported that the disability of the petitioner has been assessed at 56% in the lower right limb with shortening under the Permanent Physical Rehabilitation Programme (PPRP)".

Sh. Chhabra, the learned counsel representing the State submits that in view of the aforesaid report, the department will take an appropriate action to consider the petitioner's claim for promotion, if he is found eligible.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of while directing the competent authority to consider the petitioner's claim for promotion, if he is otherwise suitable and entitled.

Needless to observe that the competent authority shall pass the order within a period of 8 weeks from today, positively.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
