On 05.07.2023, the following order was passed by this
Court:-

“It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that after settlement of the dispute before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, petitioner is not approaching him.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondent-complainant submits that as per the settlement arrived between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, an amount of ₹12 lacs was to be paid by the petitioner, out of which ₹1 lac was to be transferred in the name of Nishan Singh through bank transfer upto 02.05.2023. The remaining amount of ₹11 lacs was to be paid by way of monthly instalments of ₹50,000/- starting from 10th day of every month till April, 2025. Learned counsel submits not even a single penny has been paid till date.

As per request of learned counsel for the petitioner, let the matter be put up on 14.07.2023.”

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after effecting the compromise, he has no further instructions from the petitioner.

In view of the afore-said statement, when nobody else has appeared for the petitioner, this petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
