Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No.4 to decide the show cause notice dated 12.12.2022 (Annexure P-1).

Learned Sr. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners has referred to the order dated 08.06.2023 (Annexure P-6) passed by the State Appropriate Authority (PNDT), Panchkula in Appeal No.197 of 2023 wherein the respondent No.4 – District Appropriate Authority, Faridabad has been directed to take expeditious decision on the show cause notice dated 12.12.2022 and preferably within a period of 15 days.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from Dr. Ramniwas, Medical Officer, PNDT, Faridabad, informs that the Competent Authority has already passed a final order on the above mentioned show cause notice on 25.07.2023.

Learned Sr. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners, however, contends that the copy of the said order has not been supplied to him.

Be that as it may, the grievance espoused by the petitioners herein with regard to directing respondent No.4 to decide the show cause notice dated 12.12.2022, has since become infructuous in view of the statement made by learned State Counsel on instructions from Dr. Ramniwas, Medical Officer, PNDDT, Faridabad.

The respondents shall, however, ensure that the copy of the said order that has been passed on the alleged show cause notice dated 12.12.2022 is furnished to the learned Sr. Counsel for the petitioners. The petitioners shall thereafter be at liberty to take recourse to their remedies against the said order dated 25.07.2023 in accordance with law and the all the pleas that have been raised therein shall be available to the petitioners.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with the liberty as aforesaid.
