ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

Feeling aggrieved by the dismissal of the application for release of stamp vendor register, stamp papers and stamp vendor license of the petitioner, who claims to be a stamp vendor, has come up before this Court by filing the present criminal revision petition.

2. Counsel for the State on instructions submits that given the allegations, petitioner's license has already been cancelled and once the license is cancelled, there is no justification to release his register to the petitioner. Moreover, the recovered record is vital evidence for final adjudication of the trial, so, the same cannot be released.

3. Given the stand of the State, no ground to release the record is made out and the petition is dismissed. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
