The present petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been moved by the petitioner seeking directions to the official respondents No.1 to 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by the petitioner that there had been some property dispute between the petitioner and respondents No.4 to 15 and the petitioner has already filed civil suit and feeling aggrieved with the same, the private respondents are harassing the petitioner in one way or the other and causing apprehension of danger to her life. The petitioner had moved the representation dated 22.09.2023 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.1- The Director General of Police, Haryana Police Headquarters, Panchkula, Haryana, and again another representation (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2- The Superintendent of Police, Jind, on 05.10.2023, but till date no action thereon has been taken. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to respondent No.2-

Superintendent of Police, District Jind, to consider and dispose of the representation (Annexure P-5) in an expeditious manner in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, DAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents.
5. After hearing the respective submissions and also the averments made in the petition, without commenting on the merits thereof, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, District Jind, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 05.10.2023 (Annexure P-5) moved by the petitioner in accordance with law in an expeditious manner and the decision so taken be also intimated to the petitioner as well.
6. Disposed of.
