[1] This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioners, who claim themselves to be major.

[2] It is pleaded that both the petitioners were in love with each other since long but parents of petitioner No.1 were not happy with their relationship and they wanted to marry petitioner No.1 with some other person, which was not acceptable to her. Petitioner No.2 and his family members tried their best to convince the parents of petitioner No.1 for their marriage but all in vain. Petitioners have married each other on 15.10.2023 against the wishes of private respondents, who have threatened to harm them. Petitioners submitted representation dated 16.10.2023

(Annexure P-5), seeking protection of their life and liberty, to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Kapurthala-respondent No.2, but to no avail.

[3] Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only at this stage.

[4] Mr. Amish Sharma, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 to 3 and waives service.

[5] Heard learned counsel for the parties.

[6] Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter or commenting thereon and in particular the legality of alleged marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Kapurthala-respondent No.2, to consider the aforesaid representation dated 16.10.2023 (Annexure P-5) and in case there is any threat perception to the petitioners from the side of the private respondents, to act in accordance with law and if need be, to provide them interim protection.

[7] It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to validate the alleged marriage between the petitioners or protect them from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
