1 This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case F.I.R. No.60 dated 22.09.2022 registered under Sections 457/436/427 IPC (Sections 380/411 IPC added later on) at Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala, Punjab.

2 Custody certificate has been filed. The same is taken on record.

3 Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was nominated on the disclosure made by Rajbir Singh @ Raja and Vicky and both the co-accused stand admitted to regular bail vide order dated 03.08.2023 passed by this Court in **CRM-M-30788 of 2023**.

4 Learned counsel for the State is not in a position to dispute the fact that the petitioner was indeed nominated by Rajbir Singh @ Raja.

5 I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the records of the case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the incarceration suffered by the petitioner, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
