Prayer in the present petition is for setting aside the order dated 04.08.2023 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana calling upon the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Ludhiana to conduct an enquiry into the registration of Sale Deed No.7457 dated 19.06.1996 in favour of the petitioner.

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, who submits that an enquiry had earlier been conducted into the said allegations and the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Ludhiana had submitted a report in favour of the petitioner.

I have also perused the communication bearing No.7709/S/No.1 dated 04.08.2023. A perusal of the same shows that no adverse finding has been recorded by the office of the Deputy Commissioner against the petitioner and the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Ludhiana has been forwarded the complaint submitted by one Naresh Chander for enquiry. There is thus no prejudice or violation of any accrued right of the petitioner. Hence, the present petition is premature at this stage.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press the instant petition.

The present petition is accordingly disposed of as not pressed at this stage.

Needless to mention that the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Ludhiana shall conduct the enquiry in a fair and impartial manner by associating all the concerned parties.
