CRM-49521-2023 :

This is an application under Section 482 read with Section 439
Cr.P.C. for withdrawal of the bail petition (CRM-M-53799-2023) with
liberty to file fresh one with better particulars.

Notice of the application.

Mr. Sanish Girdhar, AAG, Punjab appears for the respondent
State and accepts notice.

Learned counsel for the petitioner–applicant submits that during
the pendency of the bail petition, final report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C.
(*challan*) has been filed, which points to the innocence of the
petitioner-applicant. It is in the light of the aforesaid that the petitioner seeks
to withdraw the bail petition with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause
of action with better particulars.

Learned State counsel has not opposed the limited prayer made
in the present application.

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In view of the above and for the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed.
