The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.73 dated 07.05.2023 registered under Sections 307, 34 IPC and Section 25 & 27 of Arms Act registered at P.S. Sirhali District Tarn Taran.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 20.10.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Jaspal Singh, DSP, Sub Division Patti, District Tarn Taran in court today, which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 20.10.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 20.10.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
