The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, praying for grant of anticipatory/pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 102 dated 13.06.2023, registered under Sections 452, 323, 355 and 427 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga (Annexure P-1).

It is submitted by counsel for the petitioner that the case against the petitioner is totally false and concocted. The petitioner is not involved in

the crime as alleged against him. Even as per the story of the prosecution, the alleged injuries suffered by the complainant in this case have been declared as simple in nature. The petitioner shall join the investigation and and when called by the police. Hence, the petitioner deserves to be protected against his arrest.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent - State.

Counsel for the State, being instructed by ASI - Sardara Singh has submitted that the petitioner is directly involved in the case as one of the participants in the crime. However, it is not disputed that all the injuries suffered by the complainant are found to be simple in nature.

In view of the above, but without commenting any further on merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. In the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on bail, subject to his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
