1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 05.09.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-19739-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Ashima Brar, Director General of Secondary Education, Haryana, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 05.09.2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 07.11.2023 has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioners has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left un-addressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
