The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent authorities to take appropriate action to provide proper protection to the petitioner so that the petitioner can carry out construction in his land.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner contends that the private respondents are not allowing the petitioner to raise construction on his own land, the demarcation whereof has already been done by the respondent authorities pursuant to the disposal of the writ petition by this Court.

After arguing the matter at some length, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition so as to take recourse to the alternative remedies available to the petitioner in accordance with law.
