The present application has been filed for preponing the present case from 25.08.2023 to some actual date of hearing.

Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana and Mr. Sanjeev Kumar, Advocate for the complainant who are present in the Court, accept notice on behalf of the respondent and raise no objection for the grant of the prayer as made in the present application.

Keeping in view the averments made in the application, which are duly supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed.

The main case is preponed from 25.08.2023 to today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the present petition has been filed for grant of regular bail but the petitioner will be satisfied in case the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial in a time bound manner so that the petitioner does not suffer any further incarceration.

Keeping in view the fact that out of total 34 cited witnesses, only 10 have been examined so far and as per the allegations of the petitioner, the witnesses who have been summoned are not appearing despite issuance ofailable warrants. The trial Court is directed to conduct the trial in a manner required for so as to secure the presence of the witnesses concerned by adopting the method as envisaged under the Criminal Procedure Code and even the non-ailable warrants can be issued in case the Court feels that the witnesses are trying to avoid their testimony despite service.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, the trial Court is directed that all the efforts be made to conclude the trial within a period of six months from the next date of hearing i.e. 04.10.2023.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
