This petition is filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 156, dated 18th June, 2023, under Secitons 21(b), 29, 27-A of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'the Act'), registered at Police Station Sadar, Ratia, District Fatehabad.

2. Reply dated 9th November, 2023 filed by way of affidavit of HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ratia is taken on record. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Hansraj submits that in pursuance of the order dated 20th October, 2023 passed by this court, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has furnished the requisite bails bonds with surety as well as undertaking.
