1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 25.08.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Collector-respondent No.2.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as respondent No.4 have jointly pointed out that in the present case, the matter has been compromised vide detailed compromise deed dated 04.12.2023 and the said compromise has been placed on record as Annexure P-16 along with application bearing No.CM-20976-CWP-2023 and as per the said compromise, the present writ petition is to be withdrawn. It is further jointly

submitted that both the parties would be bound by the terms of the compromise. Today, the petitioner as well as respondent No.4 are present in the Court and they have been duly recognized by their counsel and have jointly stated that they are bound by the terms of the compromise.

3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn in view of compromise deed dated 04.12.2023 (Annexure P-16).

4. The petitioner as well as respondent No.4 would be bound by the terms and conditions of the said compromise.

5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
