On the basis of the status report dated 17.12.2022, learned State counsel submits that the truck from which recovery of 52 Kgs of poppy husk was made was owned by the petitioner. Subsequently, the house of the petitioner was raided in the presence of the village Sarpanch and 55 Kgs of poppy husk was recovered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the house from which recovery of 55 Kgs of poppy husk was effected does not belong to the petitioner.

The submission can not be accepted in view of the affidavit filed on behalf of the State.

Recovery is of commercial quantity and, thus, petitioner is not entitled for grant of anticipatory bail.

The petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
