The instant writ petition raises a challenge to the order dated 06.11.2018 (Annexure P-17), passed by respondent No.3 whereby the respondent while allowing the appeal has restricted the relief to the petitioner only to the extent of renewal of her Agency and restoration of renewal commission without interest.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the petitioner is entitled to the restoration of renewal commission along with interest.

Learned counsel for the respondent-Insurance Company, however, contends that the petitioner has an efficacious remedy in the form of Regulation 24 of the Life Insurance Corporation of India (Agents) Regulations, 2017 as per which a memorial may be submitted by an agent to the Chairman-cum-Managing Director of the Life Insurance Corporation. He contends that even though there is a time period specified for submissions of such a memorial, however, in the event the same being submitted now, the Life Insurance Corporation would not raise the issue of delay in submission of such memorial.

In view of aforesaid alternative efficacious remedy available under the aforesaid Rules, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the authorities concerned for redressal of his grievances in accordance with law.

Disposed of as withdrawn with liberties as aforesaid.
