Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.287 dated 15.06.2018 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 201, 120-B IPC at Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari. The allegations are that the said FIR has been registered on the basis of bank loan availed by the petitioner in the year 2010 and the petitioner failed to repay the said loan.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of the previous order of interim bail.

The State counsel on instructions from SI Birender Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and further submits that now the petitioner is not required for further investigation or custodial interrogation by the police.

Admittedly, the petitioner is aged about 78 years and is not required by the police for the purpose of further investigation.

In the light of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 16.12.2022 is

hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2)
Cr.P.C.
