1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the order dated 05.01.2022 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.2 and order dated 29.07.2022 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.1.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that since, respondent No.3 has died and at this stage, there is no further cause to pursue the case and thus, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
