The present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is filed seeking quashing of FIR No.154 dated 27.08.2017 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 447, 511 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Division No.3, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar along with all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 23.10.2020 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present

petition has become infructuous as the offences got compounded and the petitioners herein stand acquitted of the charges levelled against them in the present case, vide order dated 14.02.2023, passed by the Court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar. Copy thereof is supplied by learned counsel for the petitioners in Court today, which is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

The aforesaid fact is also not disputed by learned State counsel as well as learned counsel representing respondent No.2.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
