On 23.10.2023, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.106, dated 07.07.2023 under Sections 326, 325, 323, 148 and 149 of the IPC registered at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner inter alia contends that injury No. 7 is attributed to the petitioner, which is a bruise and is a simple injury. Grievous injury is not attributed to the petitioner. Besides, there was a delay of 14 days in registration of the instant FIR and that the cross version of the petitioner is not being recorded.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Niharika Sharma, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Learned State counsel is not in a situation to controvert that the injury No.7 attributed to the petitioner is not grievous in nature and/or that any injury other than injury No. 7 is attributable to the petitioner

To come up on 04.12.2023, for further

consideration.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Agency. In the event of petitioner joining investigation, he shall be admitted to interim bail by the arresting officer/investigating officer on furnishing of bail bonds by him to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/investigating officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Today, on instructions from ASI Sukhwant Singh, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 23.10.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 23.10.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
