In view of the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is
allowed and the main case is ordered to be taken on board today itself.

Main Case

1. Prayer is for grant of regular bail in case having FIR No.295 dated
25.6.2022 registered under Section 379-A IPC at Police Station City
Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa.
2. The allegations in nut-shell are that on 25.6.2022, 3 unknown
motorcyclists snatched mobile phone Vivo-1906 having SIM

No.8168138667 belonging to complainant-Komal. During investigation of the case, the petitioner was arrested.

3. The counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and is incarcerated since 8.9.2022 and that during trial complainant has not supported the case of prosecution. So prayer is made that the petitioner be released on regular bail.
4. The instant petition is resisted by the State counsel, who on instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar submits that the petitioner is one of the miscreants who snatched mobile phone from complainant Komal on 25.6.2022. The State counsel further apprised the Court that petitioner is in custody since 8.9.2022 and further submits that the trial is going on.
5. I have considered the submissions made by counsel for the parties.
6. As per the report submitted by the trial Court, complainant stands examined and copy of her testimony is also available on record, as per which, she has not supported the case of prosecution while appearing in the witness box.
7. In view of the above, as it will take considerable time for the trial to terminate, so no fruitful purpose is going to be served by prolonging judicial custody of the petitioner for indefinite period.
8. Thus, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to
