VIVEK PURI, J.(ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in the case bearing FIR No. 54 dated 21.04.2022 under Sections 341/325/34 IPC and Sections 308 and 367 IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Shri Hargobindpur, District Batala.

2. On 05.12.2022, the Coordinate Bench of this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the allegation in the present case was giving a dang blow on the left leg which is a non-vital part of the body. He further submitted that petitioner is not involved in any other case and has got clean antecedents and he has been falsely implicated in the present case.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amit Rana, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab.

Adjourned to 15.05.2023.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when called by the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, he shall be released on interim bail by the Arresting/Investigating Officer on his furnishing bail bonds/sureties to his satisfaction, subject to the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Avdesh Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.
5. Keeping in view the entire circumstances, sufficient grounds are made out to extend the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, order dated 05.12.2022, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is made absolute.
6. Petition is allowed.
