1. Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing sale notice dated 16.11.2022 (Annexure P-5) issued under Section 8 (6) for sale of residential house of the petitioners being illegal, arbitrary, malafide and against principles of natural justice as well as against provisions of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he has instructions to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail their

remedy/remedies as may be available to them in accordance with law for redressal of their grievances.

3. Writ petition is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned.
