Status report by way of affidavit of Jasbinder Singh, PPS, DSP, Dakha, District Ludhiana has been filed in Court on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4-State of Punjab. The same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Based on the aforementioned report, learned State counsel submits that cancellation reports have been approved and presented in the Court concerned on 19/22.09.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the aforestated cancellation reports have been filed in some other case and in the present case, grievance of the petitioner is regarding non-registration of an FIR despite submission of the complaint/representation.

On the previous date of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner was directed to show as to how the present petition seeking issuance of directions to register an FIR, is maintainable.

Today, neither any argument has been addressed regarding the

said issue nor any law has been cited on the same. Thus, the present petition is liable to be dismissed on the ground of availability of an efficacious alternative remedy.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the petition with liberty to avail the alternate remedy, as per law.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty aforementioned.
