SANJAY VASHISTH, J. (Oral)

Order dated 13.12.2022 passed by this Court says as under:

“By way of filing this petition, petitioner is seeking direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that dispute of petitioner is with respondents No.5 to 7, and when the efforts for settling the dispute in peaceful manner were resorted by the parties, it could not materialize due to unwarranted interference of respondent No.4 – SHO, PS Maloud, Police District Khanna.

On asking of the Court, Mr. JS Arora, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 (State).

Let requisite copies of the complete paper book be supplied to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Remaining respondents be served through dasti process as well.”

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that now there is no such interference as recorded in the said order dated 13.12.2022 and therefore, she has instruction to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
