Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0089 dated 15.10.2022, under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women, District Patiala.

Vide order dated 19.12.2022, this Court while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail, directed the petitioner to join investigation and the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2, at the outset, submits that although the order dated 29.04.2023 was conveyed to respondent No.2, however, he has received an information that the minor daughter of respondent No.2 is unwell and on that score she could not appear in person Court today. He further submits that he has instructions from the

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complainant to receive the ornaments, which shall be handed over by the petitioner.

Accordingly, the ornaments i.e. one pair of gold earrings and one gold ring has been handed over to learned counsel for the complainant/respondent No.2, today in the Court and receipt thereof is taken on record.

In the light of the fact that the parties have entered into an agreement/settlement and shall be parting ways, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 19.12.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
