The present petition has been filed for quashing of DDR No.17, dated 20.04.2019 registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala under Sections 323, 325, 506, 148 & 149 IPC in FIR No.46, dated 15.03.2019, registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 148 & 149 IPC on the basis of compromise.

Pursuant to order dated 19.12.2022, report dated 12.01.2023 has been received from Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sultanpur Lodhi, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.
