1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.205 dated 28.09.2019 under Sections 420 and 404 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Phase-1, SAS Nagar (Mohali), Annexure P-1, alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.
2. State counsel has specific instructions to state that after conclusion of investigation, a cancellation report was filed, which was accepted by the learned Judicial Magistrate. However, thereafter the complainant has filed a protest petition, which is pending.
3. In view of the above development, prayer made in the petition has become infructuous.
