Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.142 dated 23.8.2021 registered under Sections 323, 324, 506, 34, 326 IPC at Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

On the last date of hearing, interim bail was granted to the petitioner with direction to join the investigation on the ground that no specific injury was attributed to him and he simply caught the complainant from her leg.

Today, counsel for the petitioner apprised the court that by virtue of the aforesaid order of interim bail, the petitioner joined the investigation with the police.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh apprised the Court that indeed, the petitioner has joined the investigation and got

effected recovery of the weapon used in the commission of the crime and the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 5.12.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
