This order shall dispose of two connected writ petitions i.e.

CWP-PIL-243-2019 and CWP-20386-2020. For the sake of convenience,

facts are being extracted from CWP-PIL-243-2019.

2. The present petition has been filed seeking writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 3 to 5 to complete the enquiry i.e. VE No. 22/17, which is pending with Vigilance Bureau, Punjab since December, 2017.

3. During the pendency of this writ petition, status report by way of affidavit of Tejinderpal Singh, P.P.S., DSP, E.O.W, Vigilance Bureau, Punjab, S.A.S. Nagar on behalf of respondents No. 3 to 5 dated 28.10.2021 has been filed (at page No. 388 of the paper-book). As per the status report, the respondents have completed the enquiry on the complaint and recommendations for registration of FIR has been made vide letter No. 3608-VB/S-5 dated 29.01.2021 (Annexure R-2/T).

4. Learned counsel for the State, while referring to order dated 07.07.2023 passed in **CRWP-6175-2023** titled as **Akashdeep Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others**, states that the recommendations are being challenged therein which is pending before the learned Single Judge.

5. Since the main prayer of the petitioner was to complete enquiry and the recommendations are being challenged in **CRWP-6175-2023**, this petition is disposed of as no further directions are required to be passed.

6. Pending applications stand disposed of.
