The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0247 dated 30.10.2022 registered under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149, 506 IPC, 1860 and Section 307 IPC, 1860 (added later on) at Police Station Samana, District Patiala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 05.12.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from SI Aarvinder Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 05.12.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
