The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., for issuance of directions to the respondents No. 2 &3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation after registration of a criminal case according to law on the basis of complaint dated 25.07.2022.

Status report by way of an affidavit of Manjeet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Sardulgarh, District Mansa on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 has been filed, which is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to counsel for the petitioner today in Court.

Para 4 of the status report reads as under:-

“That in the light of aforementioned facts, complaint moved by the petitioner and facts of the petition filed by the petitioner were found to be untruthful and meritless and present petition seems to be filed by the petitioner with mischievous and mala fide intention, best known to the petitioner. Moreover, no evidence

was presented by the petitioner, proving passing of threats to the petitioner. As such, above mentioned petition deserves to be dismissed qua the answering respondents.”

A perusal of para 4 of the status report makes it crystal clear that inquiry was conducted on the complaint dated 25.07.2022, which has been found to be false and thereafter the same has been consigned to the record.

In the light of aforesaid fact, no cause of action survives in the petition in favour of the petitioner and the petition is thus disposed, as having been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.
