The present order shall disposed of two writ petitions bearing CWP-37915-2018 titled “*Sonu Ram and Others versus Bar Association, Bahadurgarh*” and CWP-37951-2018 titled “*Ravinder Dahiya & Others versus the Bar Association, Bahadurgarh & Others*”.

For the facility of reference, facts have been noticed from CWP-37915-2018 titled “*Sonu Ram and Others versus Bar*”

Association, Bahadurgarh”.

The above said writ petitions have been filed for raising a challenge to an approved site plan/drawings (Annexure P-1) & the impugned terms & Conditions of allotment of Lawyers Chambers dated 03.10.2017 and 21.10.2017 (Annexure P-2 & P-3) respectively along with the impugned allotment of chambers on 11.12.2017 which have been done allegedly in violation of the norm/policy fixed by the Building Committee (Haryana), Punjab & Haryana High Court.

Counsel for the parties are ad idem that a similar controversy had earlier come up before this Court in CWP-27899 of 2017 titled “Manjeet and Others versus The *Bar Association, Bahadurgarh & Others* which was disposed of after recording the extracts of the minutes of meeting of the Building Committee (Haryana) of this Court held on 30.01.2018.

Counsel for the parties are ad idem that the present writ petitions can be disposed of in terms of the order dated 16.10.2019 passed in the above said CWP-27899 of 2017.

In view of the consensus arrived at between the parties, the present petitions are disposed of in terms of the order dated 16.10.2019 passed in the above said CWP-27899 of 2017 (supra).
