Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.13 dated 12.2.2020 registered under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149, 307 IPC at Police Station Nandgarh, District Bathinda.

Reply filed on behalf of the State by way of affidavit of Amarjit Singh, DSP, PBI, Homicide and Forensic, Addl. Charge (Rural), District Bathinda is ordered to be taken on record.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of earlier order of interim bail passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation with the police.

State counsel on instructions from HC Kulbir Singh apprised the Court that indeed the petitioners have joined the investigation with the police and got effected recovery of the weapon used by them in the

commission of the crime and that now the petitioners are not required by the

police for further investigation in this case.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties and that the complainant/injured is having no objection if the present petition is allowed.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 9.1.2023 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
