DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (ORAL)

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.64 dated 06.04.2017 registered under Sections 376, 342, 506, 354-D, 323, 34 IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

On 06.12.2022 this Court had passed the following order: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that over 5½ years ago the petitioner was falsely implicated in the FIR in question; the petitioner has no other criminal antecedents; after having investigated the matter the investigating agency submitted a report before the competent Court on 20.07.2017 seeking cancellation of the FIR in question; on the happening of such event the petitioner sought and got anticipatory bail by this Court on 20.11.2019; since the cancellation report submitted by the State was not accepted by the Trial Court the petitioner has been summoned as an accused to face trial; during the last over five years the petitioner has always cooperated with the investigation and for the last over three years has not misused the concession of anticipatory bail granted to him by this Court and that even now the petitioner is ready and willing to appear before the Trial Court to face trial in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and prays for time to argue the matter.

Adjourned to 20.04.2023.

In the meanwhile, subject to the petitioner appearing before the Trial Court within ten days from today he shall be admitted to interim bail to the trial Court's satisfaction.”

It is not disputed that in terms of the afore quoted order of this Court the petitioner has shown his *bonafides* by appearing before the trial court and that on such appearance he has been admitted to interim bail on 12.12.2022 to the trial court's satisfaction.

After considering the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner as recorded in the afore quoted order and because the petitioner has shown his *bonafides* by appearing before the trial court, it is directed that the trial court shall now consider making the petitioner's bail absolute in accordance with law.
