MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.397 dated 02.08.2018 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 201, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari.

Vide order dated 21.12.2022, the petitioner had been granted concession of interim bail in the following terms:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that he has borrowed a loan of Rs.2,00,000/- under Kisan Credit Card from the Bank and accordingly mortgaged his land with the bank and the original mortgage deed was presented to the Bank; that the present FIR was registered on 02.08.2018, during the period from 2010 to 2018, more than 130 FIRs have been registered against different farmers; that Manager-

Suresh Kumar and one Field Officer, of the Bank have also been arrested and that co-accused Jafaru Deen Khan and Mohmmad Habib Khan, have been granted regular bail by the learned Additional Session Judge, Rewari.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 21.12.2022, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He on further instructions submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 21.12.2022 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
