Through the instant petition, prayer has been made for issuance of directions upon the respondent concerned to investigate the complaint, with the allegations of murder of the father of the petitioner, who is stated to be a British Citizen.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh, submits that the complaint was thoroughly inquired into, and after obtaining the medical as well as the forensic report, it was concluded that the cause of death of the father of the petitioner was natural.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 04.12.2023, the following order was passed:-

“Through the instant petition, prayer is made for investigating the complaint with the allegations of murder of father of the petitioner, who is stated to be a British Citizen. Today, no one has caused an appearance on behalf of the petitioner. The instant matter

is pending since 2018.

Purely in the interest of justice, adjourned to 20.12.2023.

Last opportunity is granted to learned counsel for the petitioner to cause an appearance and address his arguments.

Registry is directed to inform the learned counsel for the petitioner for the next date of hearing.

To be shown in the urgent list.”

As per office report, learned counsel for the petitioner has been duly informed about the next date of hearing through e-mail, but no one has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner today in the Court. In the present petition, for the last many dates, learned counsel for the petitioner has not caused any appearance.

Considering the stand taken by the learned State counsel *qua* the complaint filed by the present petitioner, this Court refrain to pass any further orders, however giving liberty to the petitioner to take alternate remedy, in case the grievance of the petitioner still exists.

Dismissed with aforesaid liberty.
