The instant petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.394 dated 18.08.2021, registered under Sections 166-A, 409, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC, at Police Station, Civil Lines, Kaithal (Section 166-A IPC dropped during investigation).
