This is the second petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C praying for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.187 dated 9.6.2021 under Section 302 IPC and section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station, Model Town, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is behind bars since 9.6.2021.

Learned State counsel submits that out of the total 17 prosecution witness only 3 remain to be examined and the next date before the Trial Court is 27.1.2023.
