The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of directing the respondent No.2 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioners and their family members at the hands of respondents No.3 and 4 who are harassing and threatening the petitioners of false implication at the instant of respondent No.5.

Reply on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 by way of affidavit of Kulwant Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Crime against Women and Children, Hoshiarpur has been filed in which it has been mentioned that an application was submitted by respondent No.5 against the petitioners and her husband Amrinder Singh levelling allegations of harassment, beatings, misappropriation of dowry articles and compelling for developing physical relation. The said application was marked for inquiry to the Incharge Women Cell, Hoshiarpur and that as the issue was within the jurisdiction of Commissionerate, Jalandhar Police and Amritsar Police, therefore, the said

complaint was recommended to be sent to Commissionerate, Jalandhar Police for further proceedings and to sent the inquiry report to SSP, Hoshiarpur.

In view of the above stand taken by the respondent-State, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition at this stage.

Disposed of as not pressed at this stage.
