The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.974 dated 16.11.2022 under Sections 18-A, 18-C of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and under Section 15(2) (B) of the Indian Medical Council Act and Sections 336 and 420 of IPC registered at Police Station Azad Nagar, Hisar, District Hisar, Haryana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 13.01.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The status report dated 14.03.2023 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record. The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 13.01.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 13.01.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
