1. The petitioner in the instant (second) petition is seeking anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.156 dated 17.11.2019 under Sections 406/420 of the IPC, Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014 and Section 24 of the Emigration Act, 1983 registered at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that the petitioner is ready to appear, and surrender before the Court below. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till his appearance before the Court below and with directions to the Court that his bail application, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Mohit Kapoor, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel

for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioner to appear and surrender before the Court below within 07 days from today. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

6. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Court below within 07 days, this order shall be of no avail to him, thereafter. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner move an application for bail before the Court below, the same shall be decided expeditiously, by the Court, in accordance with law.
