This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.PC for quashing of the FIR No.71 dated 19.03.2019, under Section 376(2) of 1860, registered at Police Station Sector-34, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Learned counsel for the Union Territory submits that even statement of the petitioner/accused under Section 313 Cr.PC stands recorded, and the trial is at the fag end. It was adjourned to 10.03.2023 for defence evidence, however, no witness was examined on the date fixed. The trial has now been adjourned to 16.03.2023 for defence evidence, if any, or arguments.

2. In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition.
