Three identical writ petitions i.e. Civil Writ Petition No.28050, 28158 and 28457 of 2022 have come up for final disposal.

The petitioners pray for issuance of appropriate directions to the respondents to allow the petitioners to appear for scrutiny of documents.

By interim orders, the petitioners have been permitted to appear for scrutiny of documents after they had failed to appear on the dates originally reserved for the same.

Sh. Charanpreet Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, admits that the matter is still under consideration of the department.

Since the petitioners have already been permitted to be participate in the process of scrutiny of documents and their documents have been scrutinized, therefore, now the petitioners shall not be disqualified on the ground that they did not attend the counseling on the initial dates allotted to them. However, this shall not be treated as a precedent.

With these observations, the writ petitions are disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
